- Administrative Support Team

We will recognize BPA Cares and Statesmen Torch Awards for those chapters and students who qualify during the Awards Session. Please make sure the entries are submitted by February 19, 2020 on www.bpa.org.

You will need one chaperone for every seven students that you bring to SLC. Please ask your chaperones to follow dress code.

Judged events need to be pre-submitted by midnight EST February 14, 2020. Those events that will be pre-submitted will be:

- Digital Game Design Team
- Graphic Design Promotion (Only top 10 will present at SLC)
- Introduction to Video Production Team
- Web Site Design Team
- Entrepreneurship Exploration (Only top 10 will present at SLC)

Please note that the student must be logged in for the pre-submit system to be able to upload materials for contest.

- √ Online registration will be open from January 9 to January 24, 2020. Register at <http://indianabpa.org/slcReg.php>. Make sure you select the Middle Level Registration.
- √ Presubmit judged events by February 14, 2020.
- √ Presubmit required events between February 10 and February 21.
- √ Submit Torch resumes and BPA Cares documents by February 19, 2020.
- √ Mail a copy of the online registration invoice and a check or PO to Jason Hendrickson, BPA State Advisor, ML SLC Registration, PO Box 912, Huntington, IN 46750.
- √ Review contest guidelines with students.
- √ Review dress code, code of conduct, and medical forms with students. Inform students of your emergency plan. Inform them where to meet outside of the hotel in the case of an emergency.
- √ Registration will be from 8:15 am to 8:45 am on Sunday, March 8 in the Indianapolis Boardroom, 2nd Floor of the Downtown Marriott. Awards Session is scheduled to start at 4:00 pm.
